Rules: 2018 Modified Racing Series Rules Apply.

No Exceptions. Anti-Intrusion Roof Plate and Blewett Bars are Mandatory.

Tires: Only Modified Racing Series Hoosier tires may be Used. All teams are subject to their current tire rotation Schedule. Modified Racing Series Tire Rules apply.

Rulebook: All competitors understand that by registering for this Modified Racing Series event, they have read the Modified Racing Series 2018 Official Rulebook.

Competitors also agree to abide by these rules and regulations And any changes that may be ordered by Modified Racing Series officials at any event.

Fuel: Sunoco Race Fuels is the official race fuel of the Modified Racing Series and must be run at all times. Fuel is subject to testing. New England Race Fuels provides at track service at all events.

Membership Policy: All car owners and drivers must obtain a Modified Racing Series Membership License to be eligible to participate in a Modified Racing Series event. To qualify for event bonuses, contingencies, or banquet drawings, you must apply associated decals to your race car.

Spotters: It is the responsibility of all car owners participating in a Modified Racing Series event to provide a qualified spotter. That spotter must report to the assigned Modified Racing Series official in the designated spotters area prior to any heat race. All spotters are required to monitor race control via scanner on frequency 452.81250
